

# WordPowered YouWrite

*Users of the website who are teachers of English (of any nationality) are invited to submit poetry, short stories or longer fiction for consideration for publication on the WordPowered YouWrite website [www.wordpowered.org](http://www.wordpowered.org)*

*Please observe the following guidelines:*

1. Only teachers of English can submit texts. The teachers may be of any nationality, and at any stage of their career from trainee teachers to retired teachers. They may work at any level e.g. primary, secondary, tertiary, and may work in either the public or private sectors.
2. Submissions should be made by email to [youwrite@wordpowered.org](mailto:youwrite@wordpowered.org) attaching a Word Document with name, country and email address for contact.
3. Authors may publish using a pen name if they desire.
4. Short stories should be typed in Arial 11, using 1.5 spacing. (Poems can take any format)
5. Texts may be of any length.
6. Texts will be subject to an editing process. Edited texts will not be published without the permission of the author.
7. The editors reserve the right not to publish any text submitted to them. The editors will not enter into correspondence if a text is rejected.
8. Authors agree to have their work published on the WordPowered website without payment of any fees, but they will retain the authorial rights over their production.
9. The subject matter of the texts will be deemed to be of interest to other teachers of English by the author. Consideration should be given to submitting pieces which may be used by other teachers in their classes as part of English language teaching.
10. Pieces accepted the editors will take into consideration: originality, imaginative use of the language, command of the language and appeal to a worldwide readership.
11. A condition of submission is that other users of the website will be invited to comment on the text in the blog/forum set up for this purpose.
12. Accepted texts will be published on the website for a period of 12 months. This period may be extended by agreement of both parties.
